We have a MULE now for carting and bathroom runs. This will be the first camping trip of the summer. We have to pull out all the stuff we put away for the winter (BBQ, tables, etc)

We meet around 5 pm on Saturday night and if the weather allows, we run the dogs between 7 and 9 pm. If it is warm we eat dinner first and then run them. They run from 1 mile to 7 miles, again it is based on the weather... Dinner is a

group effort.

Vaccine Clinic

Thank you to all that participated in the Clinic last month that Dr. Rusher did for us at her clinic. We received over \$300 for rescue.

Dr. Rusher has offered that all BASH members can come to the clinic any month that she is doing it and still receive BASH prices for vaccines. Rabies will now be \$6 and all REGULAR vaccines will be \$10. If you want a special vaccine that may cost a little more she will do those also.

You can also go to the clinic to purchase your flea, tick and heartworm products.

She sells them at approximately the same price as PetMeds. The difference is that a large portion of the profit when she sells it, comes back to BASH for our rescue.






