

Coal Creek Open Space Preserve/Russia Ridge Preserve

There is a Caltrans vista point pullout area on Skyline Blvd (opposite Russian Ridge Preserve gate RR01, approx 1.2 mi past Page Mill Rd, and you can access Coal Creek Preserve from there.
