

We have a MULE for carting and bathroom runs.This will be the last camping trip of the summer. We will try to plan a couple more for the fall, you will have to watch for the dates We meet around 5 pm on Sunday night and if the weather allows, we run the dogs between 7 and 9 pm. If it is warm we eat dinner first and

then run them. They run from 1 mile to 7 miles, again it is based on the weather... Dinner is a group effort.

Some people then camp in tents but most campout in their cars or beside them.

In the morning we rise with the sun and run the dogs again. We try different dogs in different positions and come back to a GREAT group breakfast and off the hill by 11 am.... You still have time to do things before the end of the weekend.

Most people go up for the whole event. SOMETIMES (not all the time) we have a couple that only come up for the evening part. This can only happen if we have at least two cars going down at the same time and one must have a key.
