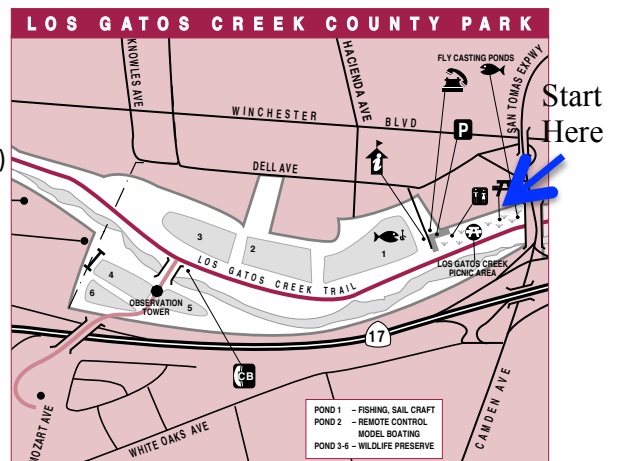

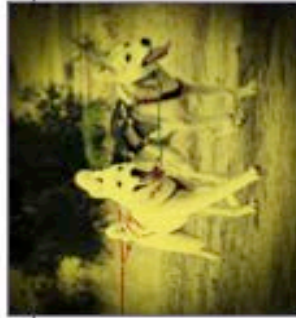
Norsled works directly with shelters in these areas, and also if there is space, shelters in other Northern
