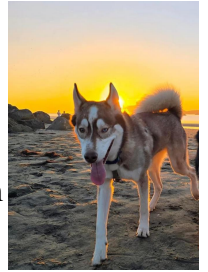

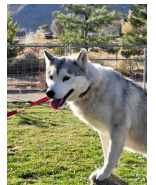

Stone has been kenneled most of his life, but was also shown in dog shows, coming to within just a few points from his AKC championship. (AKC papers are available to go along with this dog, along with pictures of his parents and relatives.) He has been around older children and other dogs and would do well in a household that had older children and/or another similar-sized dog. Stone is a climber and as such will need a secure yard or kennel. He will need an active family who is ready to take daily walks with him and otherwise teach him what it means to be a spoiled housedog. Stone is used to sleeping and traveling in a crate. He would excel with an active family and anyone who is interested in bike-joring or ski-joring.



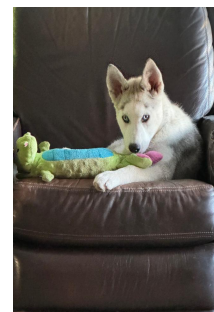
