





## Homemade Cheeseburger Dog Treats for Father's Day

These Father's Day-themed dog biscuits are crafted into mini-cheeseburgers in celebration of grill-loving dog dads everywhere. Give your pup the taste of a backyard BBQ, and he'll never forget who his favorite pet parent is. Made with the squeezable KONG Bacon & Cheese Flavor Easy Treat and Rachael Ray Burger Bites, it's as close as your pet can get to a true Father's Day cookout. Let your pup in on the Father's Day festivities with these nutritious and delicious homemade dog treats.



#### Ingredients

- 1 jar of Whisk & Wag Cheddar & Herb dog treat mix
- 1/2 cup and 1 tbsp. water
- 1/8 cup melted Petpost! coconut oil
- 10 Rachael Ray Nutrish Grain-Free Burger Bites dog treats
- 1 tube KONG Stuff'N Easy Treat Bacon & Cheese Flavor
- Generous sprinkle of organic chia seeds
- 1 egg

#### **Supplies**

- Large mixing bowl
- Small mixing bowl
- Parchment paper
- Spoon
- Sheet pan

**Preparation time:** 10 minutes **Baking time**: 25 minutes **Total time:** 35 minutes **Yield:** 10 burger dog biscuits

#### Steps

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F.
- 2. In a large bowl, add the entire jar of Whisk & Wag mix, plus water and coconut oil. Combine until a firm dough forms.
- 3. Separate the mixture into 20 teaspoon-sized balls. Flatten the balls to 1/8-inch thick to form the buns.
- 4. Crack an egg into a small mixing bowl and add 1 tbsp. of water. Whisk until blended to create an egg wash.
- 5. Use your finger to coat the top of 10 of the buns. Generously sprinkle chia seeds on top.
- 6. Place your homemade dog treats onto a baking sheet lined with parchment paper, chia side up, spacing them 1/2 inch apart.
- 7. Bake for 25 minutes.
- 8. Allow to cool for 10 minutes.
- 9. Flip over the tops of the buns and spray a dime-sized portion of KONG Easy Treat onto every bun top and bottom.
- 10.Gently press Rachael Ray Burger Bites dog treats onto the bun bottoms.
- 11.Add the bun tops, and serve one DIY dog treat to your beloved fur child!

Almost 2 months ago there was an 8 year old Siberian at the San Jose Shelter. We had no place to put him. We could board him but was that fair? Not knowing which if any foster home would take on an older dog. I posted to facebook and had a number of people interested in him. I said we would help place, we just didn't have a foster home. You have to be a member of BASH to foster..... A wonderful lady

said she would take him. I picked him pup the next day and took Lobo to her. He was older and

overweight...but very nice. She has since decided he has fit in well and she is going to keep him.

Two weeks ago Norsled and BASH were contacted about a dog that had a horrible wound on

his side at the Sacramento Shelter. Neither of us as individual groups could do much but together we did. It ended up the dog had had acid thrown on his side. With a few facebooks posts, sharing etc... Norsled was able to raise over \$8,000 which paid for the surgeries to close his side. He is now recovering and will soon be available for adoption.

Yesterday I reposted an older dog that needed a place to go. Had to try but didn't know if it would help and it did. Three people

were interested in fostering this old girl who's owner had died. All from various people sharing the post.

Why do I write about this. It is important for all that work with rescues, support rescues etc....to share what you see about our rescues with others. It is amazing what that one share will

bring to a dog that needs a foster home or a new forever home. A click of the entry and it can go around the world. We try not to put out everything, but those that have a special place in our hearts....and it is working..
