Rescue Report Randee McQueen we have been going in with SHRR (Siberian Husky Rescue Referral of California) to sponsor low cost spay neuter clinics. It's \$4000 for half day clinic. Split \$2000 BASH/\$2000 SHRR. Does about 11-16 Siberians spay/neuter. Had one in the Bay Area and one in the Central Valley. Last one did 26 Siberians. Trying to do more this summer. Want to do another in Central Valley up near Sacramento. The clinic (SnipBus) lost a vet.

BASH also helped sponsor (pay) for spay neuter at private clinics to help out two dogs that people found and are willing to foster.

Business. Still looking for ideas for club activities. Winery, beer garden with dogs. Perhaps someone to arrange hikes or Sniffspot (private dogpark), beach trips. Open to ideas and people to coordinate.

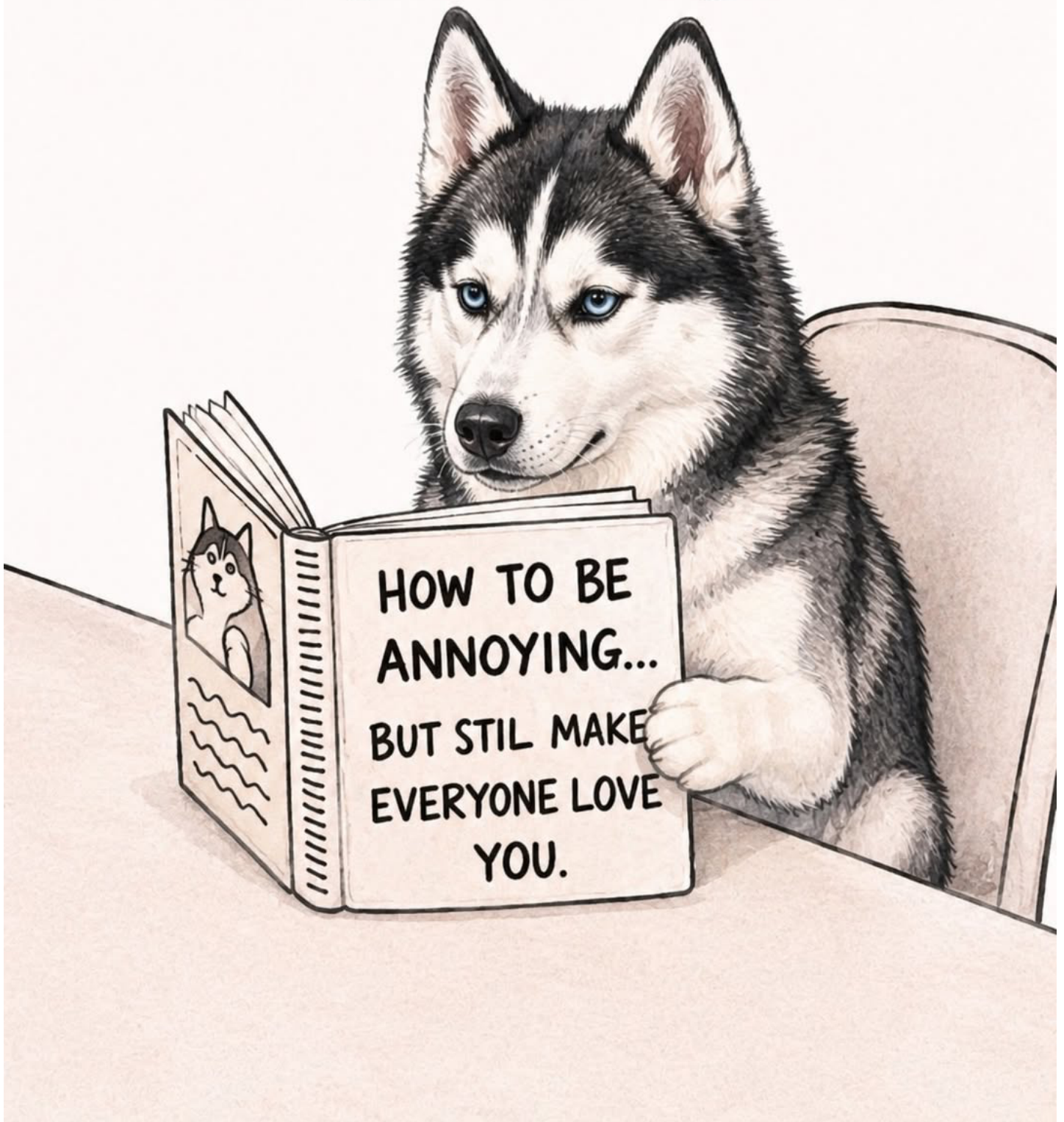

Dog-Friendly Parks & Trails

With 60 miles of coastline and beach and 30 miles of bayshore, your dog will be in heaven hiking or walking one of our many pet-friendly outdoor areas. A few noteworthy trails to check out are [Arastradero Creek Loop](#) located in Palo Alto, [Devil's Slide Trail](#) located in Pacifica, and [Pulgas Ridge Reserve](#) in Redwood City. You may also go on a hike and let your dog swim at Waterdog Lake and soak up some sunshine on their pet-friendly garden patio. If you are heading to the beach, make sure to grab the leash and bring your pooch, they will love you for it!

Hall Dog Park, San Carlos, CA

What to Expect

Nestled on the corner of a residential street and surrounded by trees, this off-leash park is a convenient, safe, and fun spot for both dogs and their people. The fully enclosed layout gives your pup the freedom to socialize and burn energy—all with your peace of mind. Dogs love running up and down the agility ramp, and you can take it all in from a shady tree or one of the picnic tables on-site. Curious explorer that your dog is, this place delivers.

Good to Know

This park is closed on Sundays.

Seal Point Park, San Mateo, CA

What to Expect

Driving up to [Seal Point Park](#), the expansive landscape and a glimpse of the beautiful bay peeking over the hills sets a relaxed, West Coast tone immediately. The large, 3-acre fenced dog park is to the far right of the parking lot and is divided into two areas—one for small dogs, one for big dogs. Just outside the fence, a water station with drinking fountains and hoses makes post-play paw cleanup easy. Beyond the dog park, Seal Point offers a network of bayside paths ideal for on-leash walks, biking, and birdwatching.

Good to Know

The dog park is closed the 1st Wednesday of every month for maintenance.

Mori Point, Pacifica, CA

What to Expect

Part of the [Golden Gate National Recreation Area](#), Mori Point is one of the Peninsula's most beloved spots for a dog-friendly hike with serious coastal payoff. Choose your adventure: the terrain ranges from a flat, breezy 0.5-mile stroll to a steeper, moderately challenging 1.5-mile route with panoramic views of the Pacifica coastline. After your hike, wander down to Sharp Park Beach—though swimming there is strongly discouraged. If you and your pup are ready for a splash, [Linda Mar Beach](#) is just 3 miles south and a great option.

Good to Know

Mori Point sits within a broader stretch of incredible [things to do in Pacifica](#)—consider making a full day of it.

Bean Hollow State Beach, Pescadero, CA

What to Expect

[Bean Hollow State Beach](#) stretches one mile along the San Mateo coast near [Pescadero](#). The northern end features rugged, pebbled shores known for tide pools and striking tafoni honeycomb rock formations, while the southern stretch offers a sandy expanse ideal for relaxing and soaking in the ocean breeze. Dogs are welcome on-leash both on the beach and along the coastal Arroyo de los Frijoles Trail. One heads-up for puppy parents: the sand is sometimes lined with seashell casings, so keep a close eye on curious mouths. Come back in different seasons for the possibility of spotting birds migrating along the Pacific Flyway—it's a place that deserves return visits.

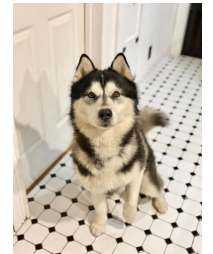

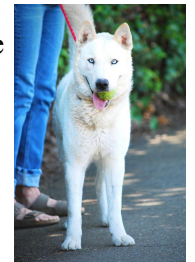

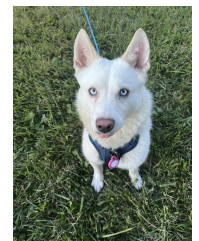

She will follow basic commands such as sit, down, come, leave it, wait. She loves to play with the other dogs that we have in the house and loves to be outdoors, camping, and go on car rides with the windows down. She walks well on a leash with minor corrections. She is exceptionally quiet for a husky and will only have the occasional vocalization. She hasn't been introduced to other animals or children yet. She tends to hide in dark small spaces until she is comfortable in a new environment and likes to find shelter in a crate. She is a very loving dog once she gets comfortable with you and loves to cuddle with big slobbery kisses. 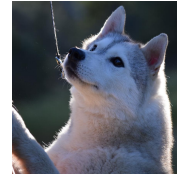
